Warren County Health Services and SE Warren Schools have partnered to offer flu vaccinations. The single best way to prevent the flu is with vaccination every year. Protecting yourself from the flu also protects the people around you who are more vulnerable to serious flu illness.

Flu vaccines will be offered:

October 19, 2017 beginning at 730 am

(starting at the Primary Center and traveling to all the schools based on returned consents/interest)

The flu vaccine will be offered based on availability. The Flu Mist will not be available this year. We are able to bill most insurance plans. (Please be aware that some insurance companies require that you see your primary physician for insurance to cover the fee of the vaccine.) If you do not have insurance or if your insurance does not cover the cost of the vaccine, the charge for the vaccine will be \$24. Payment should be made to: **Warren County Health Services** and will be collected the day of the clinic. Cash or check only accepted. Your child may be eligible for free vaccine if your child has no health insurance, is underinsured (insurance doesn't cover vaccines), has Medicaid or is of Native American/Alaskan origin.

Please complete the Screening Questionnaire and the Consent Form and bring these with you or send to the school nurse by October 19th. Additional forms will also be available.
